2024-2025 POSSIBLE RETENTIONS

- Students that fail two full year subjects or a combination of two half year courses and a full year subject will be retained in their current grade for the 2025-2026 school year.

SUMMER SCHOOL

- Students that fail the 2024-2025 school year 'may' be eligible for summer school.
- If your child qualifies for summer school and potential promotion to the next grade level, the guidance department will be in contact with parents.
- Summer school is scheduled this year at North Tonawanda Middle School.
- Summer school information will be distributed to those students that qualify for summer school when it is available.
- Summer School cost was \$120 per course last year and it may increase this year.
- A student may enroll in two courses maximum.
- North Tonawanda Middle School will host summer school this summer and

transportation is the parent's responsibility as the WCSD does not provide transportation for summer school.

- **There will be a short window of time for summer school registration.**
- Please contact your child's guidance counselor or Principal Benton with questions.
