Budget Timeline

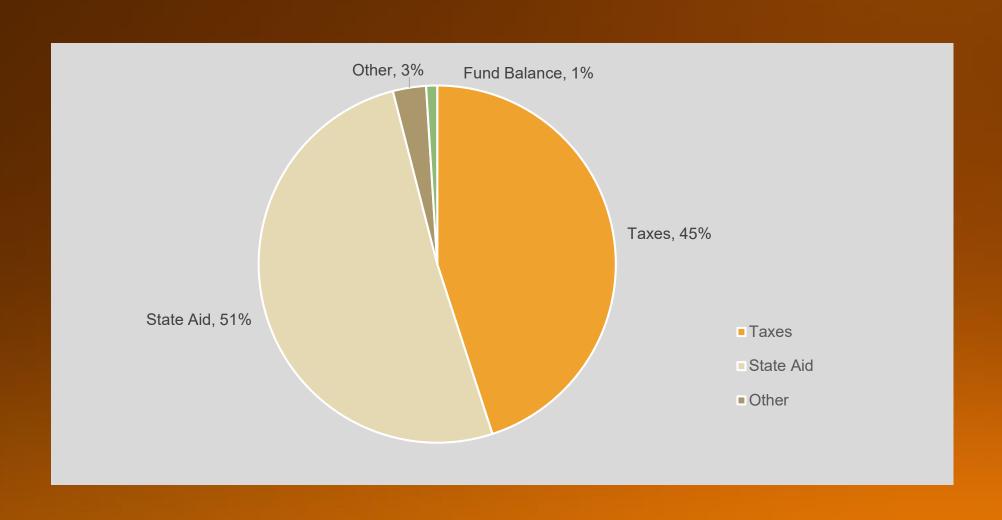


2020-2021 Budget

- Use of Appropriated Fund Balance/Reserves \$900,000

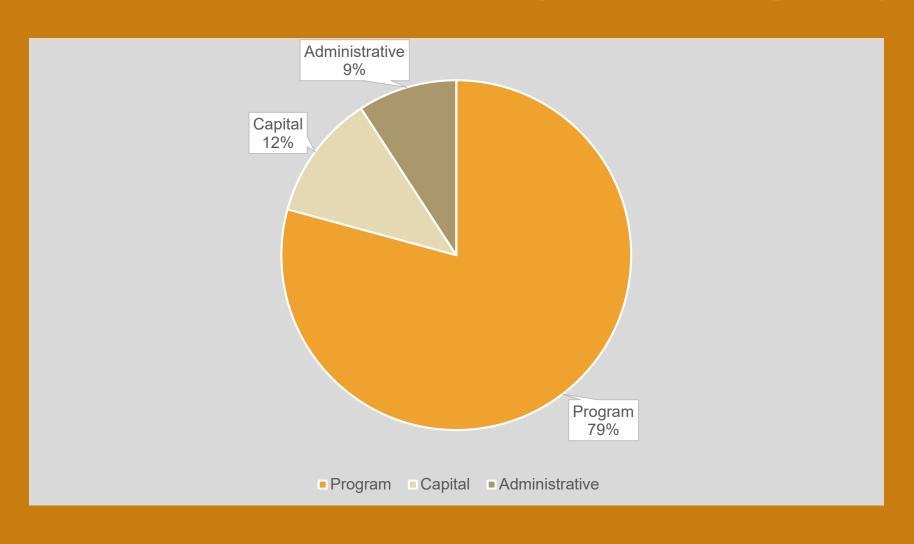

 - Contractual Lawyers, Auditors, BOCES

- In this budget we have two clerical staff retirements that are not being filled. This is due to the reduction in Foundation Aid in the State Budget announced April 3, 2020.
- The District is expecting further cuts during the 2020-21 school year due to the loss of revenue and increased expenses the State has experienced from COVID-19.
- If the State lowers revenue by reducing State Aid the District receives, the District will have to make some decisions on what must be lowered on the expenditure side.
