- McKinley Assassination Marker, 30 Fordham Drive, Buffalo, NY 14216
- **Peace Bridge**, a pedestrian bridge is available, to take photos.
- *Cobblestone Local Historic District* in Buffalo, between Illinois and Columbia Streets, by the HSBC Arena.
- War of 1812 Barracks located at the corner of Main and Evans in Williamsville
- Patriots and Heroes Park, located at 6675 Transit Road in Buffalo

- Buffalo's Naval Servicemen's Park, at 1 Naval Park Cove in Buffalo. Equipment on site: X-Ron helicopter, "Huey" helicopter, F-101F fighter jet, PTF-17 patrol boat, FJ-4B navy jet, M-41 tank, and M-84 armored personnel carrier. There is also a P-39 Airacobra aircraft there, which was one of 9,500 built in Buffalo and Niagara Falls
- Hispanic Americans Monument
- Afghanistan/Iraq Wars Memorial
- *Merchant Marine WWII Memorial*. Located in front of the *U.S.S. Sullivans* ship in the Naval Servicemen's Park
