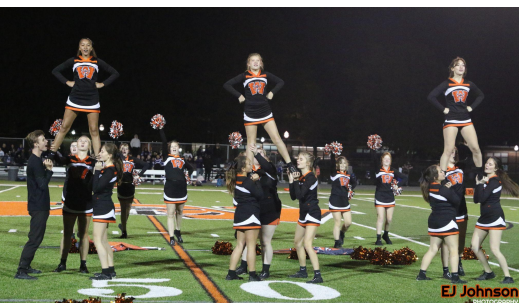
Anchored by **Brayden Lepsch, Justin Hoyt, Willy Wortkoetter, Hamza Merrick and Brandon Martin.**
