NYSED TSI Funding

The 2022-23 SIG Basic Application will be released in August 2022.

- Districts are eligible to receive \$50,000 to implement their DCIP
- \$75,000 to support the implementation of any TSI school SCEP.

NOTE:

TSI status will not be determined until after the start of the 2022-23 school year, all districts and schools currently identified for additional support should proceed with developing improvement plans for 2022-23.

Any district or school that is no longer identified as needing additional NYSED support as a result of 2021-22 data will retain access to the funding that is provided to support the implementation of their 2022-23 improvement plans.
