All students eat free!! The USDA announced that all students will eat free for the entire 2020-21 school year. This means that each student is eligible to receive one breakfast meal and one lunch meal, each day, at no charge.

While students are in school they receive free meals. Free meals are available daily for distance learners, also. Simply click on the link marked Distance Learning Meal Order Form and fill in the required areas.

Meals will be available for pick up at the high school fitness center entrance daily from 10:30-10:50 a.m. On Wednesdays, we have extended the pickup time from 10:30a.m. – noon. The menu for the distance learning meals is available under the menu tab.

When WES has remote learning Wednesdays, we will send the meals home the afternoon before so parents do not have to worry about picking them up with young children at home. The meals will need to be refrigerated when they arrive home until your child eats them the following day. If for any reason you would not like your child to receive a meal, please contact my office at 716-751-9341 x 139. In allowing your child to receive meals and participate in the Wilson Central School District meal program you help keep the program strong for families in need.
