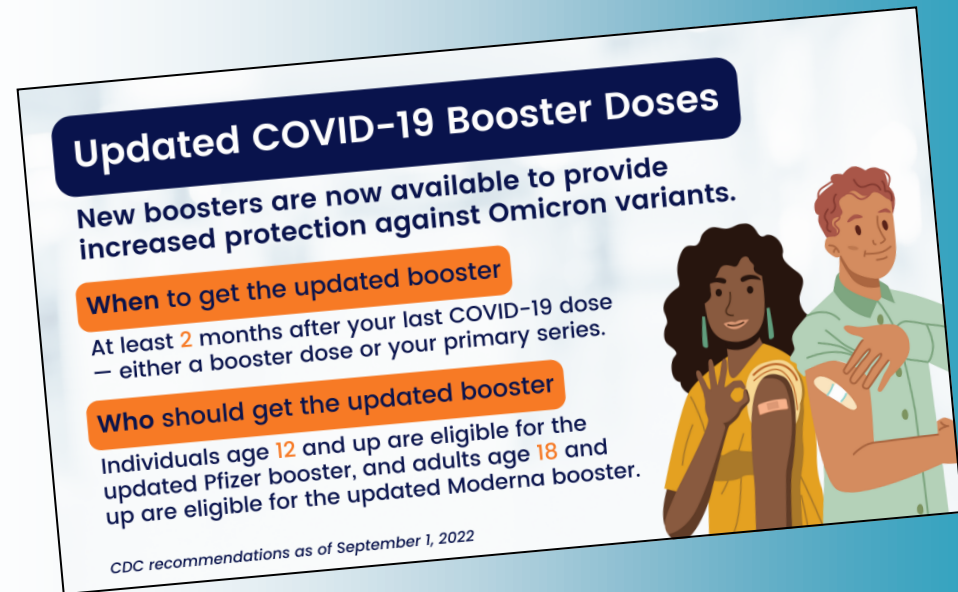

- Moderna updated (bivalent) booster—ages 18 years and older

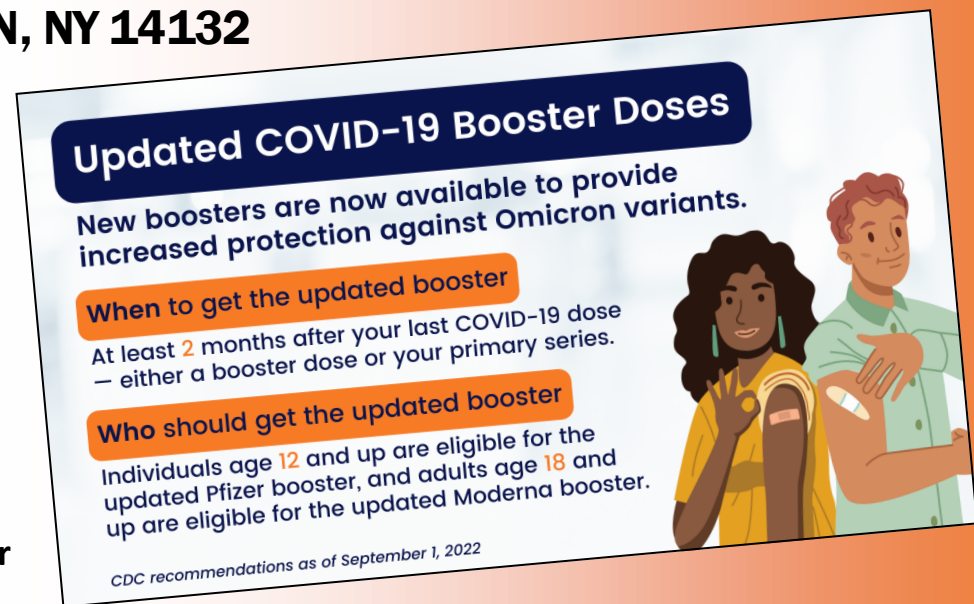
