The following vaccines are available:

- Pfizer Infant: 1st, 2nd, 3rd doses –ages 6 months—4 years
- Moderna Infant: 1st & 2nd doses—ages 6 months—5 years
- Pfizer 1st & 2nd doses— ages 5 years and older
- Novavax 1st & 2nd—ages 12 years +, Booster—age 18 years +
- Pfizer updated (bivalent) booster—ages 5 years and older
- Moderna updated (bivalent) booster—age 18 years +
- Infant updated (bivalent booster) see website for details
- Seasonal Flu—ages 6 months and older

Children and COVID-19 Vaccination

Children ages 6 months and up are now eligible for an updated (bivalent) COVID-19 vaccine.

- Children should get the updated vaccine as a booster at least 2 months after their second shot of Pfizer or Moderna.
- For children ages 6 months-4 years who get the Pfizer vaccine, the updated vaccine is used as the third shot in the series, rather than as a separate booster.
