

AHERA

In accordance with the Federal Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA, 40 CFR 763), this notice is required by Federal Regulations to inform you that Wilson Schools routinely conducts semi-annual inspections of all District buildings. This required inspection is performed in order to ascertain the condition of all asbestos containing material (ACM) remaining in all of the District's buildings.

The 2016 triennial re-inspection was completed in the months of February and March. A periodic surveillance was also completed in August. All asbestos containing materials were found to be in overall good condition and present no health hazards to building occupants.

The results of the triennial re-inspection and the periodic surveillance have been placed in the AHERA Operations and Maintenance Program binders located in the main office of each school building and a master copy located in the office of the Director of Facilities Management.
