SUMMER SCHOOL

- Students that fail the 2021-2022 school year 'may' be eligible for summer school.
- If your child qualifies for summer school and potential promotion to the next grade level, the guidance department will be in contact with parents.
- Summer School cost was \$78 per course last year and it may increase this year.
- A student may enroll in two courses maximum.
- Starpoint CSD will host summer school this summer and transportation is the parent's responsibility as the WCSD does not provide transportation for summer school.
- **There will be a short window of time for summer school registration.**
