Amy Kurtz is initially certified as Childhood Education (Grades 1-6) and is appointed to the tenure area of Elementary Education with salary and benefits per the Wilson Teachers Association Agreement. This appointment includes a four-year probationary period beginning September 5, 2018 through September 4, 2022. The probationary ending date is contingent upon the individual receiving an overall APPR rating of effective or highly effective in at least three (3) of the four (4) preceding years. Probationary employees receiving an ineffective APPR rating in their final year of probation will not be eligible for tenure at that time.
- b. Alison Hastings as Kindergarten Summer Readiness Program Instructor effective July 16, 2018 at \$26.00 per hour per WTA Agreement.
